

## USE OF POWER SUPPLY LEADS

## THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE IN PLACE IN TO ENSURE YOUR SAFETY:

- Every power lead must have a current tag confirming it has been inspected and tested in accordance with AS/NZS 3760:2010.
- Leads need to be tested and tagged every three months.
- Leads should be visually inspected for any splits, exposed wires, bulges, scorching or damage.
- You must plug in, trip the RCD then reset before use. If the RCD fails the lead must not be used.
- Only one lead shall be connected to one socket outlet.
- Any supply lead used to connect to a transportable structure, such as a caravan or tent, should be in one unbroken length.
- You cannot use extension cords.
- You cannot use double adapters.
- The lead must not be connected while coiled on a drum reel or storage box. It must be fully uncoiled while in use.

We ask for your co-operation so that your stay, and the stay of other guests, can be enjoyable. Breach of any of these rules, Health & Safety or Fire Regulations may result in you being required to leave the park immediately without refund.
